

COOKIE POLICY

Cookies are small text files that a website inserts into your navigation device when you visit a page and are stored in order to transmit information between the website and your device or between this and other sites.

Cookies can be first or third party, where:

"first part" means cookies that report the Website as a domain, while;

"third party" means cookies that relate to external domains; this happens because the websites visited can contain elements such as images, maps, specific links to pages of other websites hosted on a server other than the one on which the requested page is hosted. They are therefore those cookies that are set by a website other than the one the user is visiting.

This website (www. [▪]. [Com / it] - henceforth, for the sake of brevity, the "Website" uses cookies that can be used to make the Website easier and more intuitive or to combine the information we collect about you. You can decide to receive an alert each time a cookie is placed on your device or to disable all cookies by changing your browser settings. By disabling cookies, however, some of our services may not work properly.

1. Type of cookie

Regarding the nature of cookies, there are different types:

technical cookies are necessary to allow users to navigate correctly on a website.

It is not necessary to provide consent for technical cookies, as they are essential to ensure the services requested. In any case it is possible to block or remove technical cookies by modifying the configuration of your browser options, deactivating or deleting the cookies themselves. However, by performing these operations, you may not be able to access certain areas of the Website or use some of the services offered.

performance cookies (analytics cookies) collect anonymous information relating to the way users use the Website and its various functions (for example, pages of the Website that you visit most often; your possible interaction with our advertisements that appear on others websites; verification of opening of any communications or banners). The information collected can be used to personalize your online experience by showing specific content. Cookies for the services we use do not collect personal information.

profiling cookies have the task of creating user profiles in order to send advertising messages in line with the preferences shown by the user while browsing. Cookies can also be classified as:

- "session" cookies, which are deleted immediately and automatically when the browser is closed;
- "pre-established" cookies which will remain stored and active on the user's hard disk until the expiry date;
- "persistent" cookies, which remain in the browser for a certain period of time and allow faster and easier access to the Site. For example, a persistent cookie that our Website reads from the user's device is the chosen language for navigation. After sending the cookie, this allows the user to be automatically redirected to the site with the chosen language on future access to the Site.

2. Cookies used on the Website

Below is a table of the cookies used by the Website, which we will periodically update in relation to the cookies used from time to time. In our information on the processing of personal data [▪] you will find all the information on the ownership of the treatment and on the way in which you exercise your rights regarding personal data:

a) technical cookies, essential to allow normal and correct navigation on the Website [▪].

b) monitoring or analysis cookies, used to collect statistical information, in aggregate or non-aggregated form, on the number of users accessing the Website and how the Website is used. In particular, the Website uses the service of web analytics of Google Analytics (Google), which uses the personal data collected for the purpose of tracking and examining in aggregate form and not the use of this Application, compiling reports and sharing them with other services developed by Google. Google may use personal data to contextualize and personalize the ads of its own advertising network. To disable the Google Analytics action, refer to the link.

3. Enabling / disabling cookies through the browser

There are several ways to manage cookies and other tracking technologies. By changing your browser settings, you can accept or reject cookies or decide to receive a warning message before accepting a cookie from the websites you visit. We remind you that by completely disabling cookies in your browser you may not be able to use all our interactive features.

You can delete all the cookies installed in your browser's cookie folder. Each browser has different procedures for managing settings.
